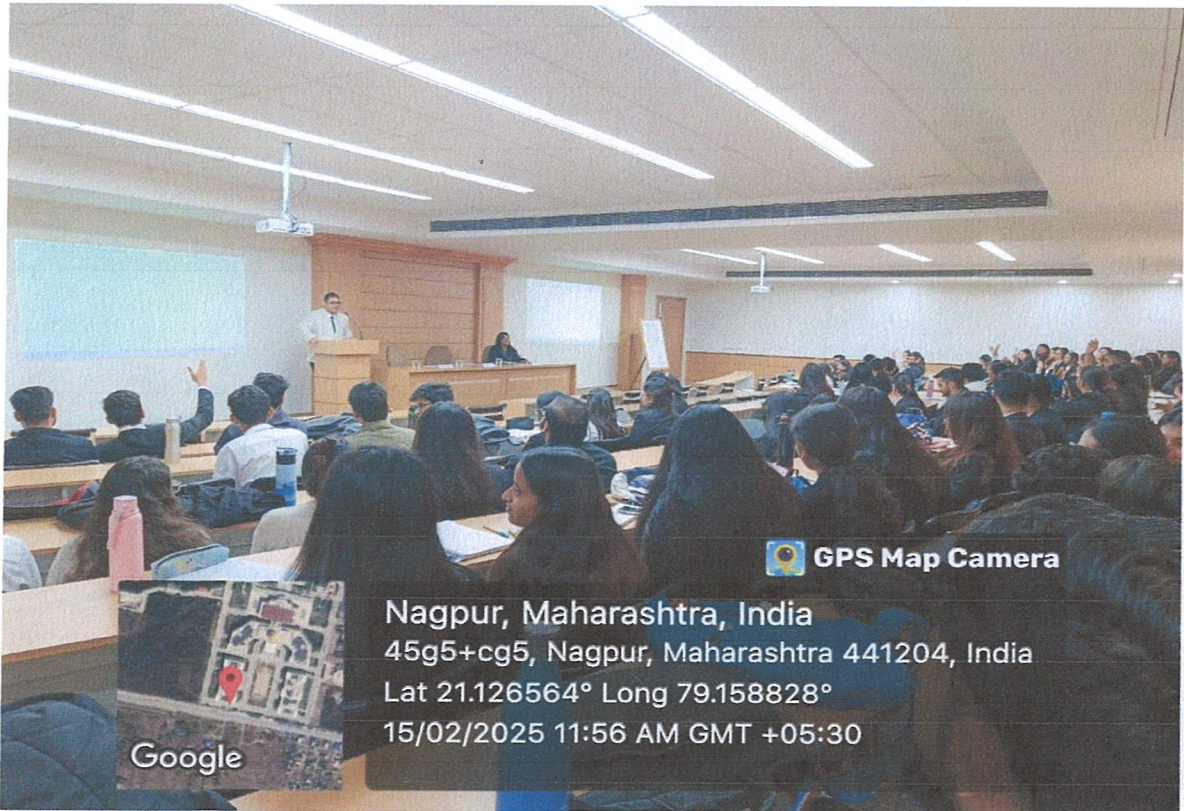




Interaction done with students by Advocate Sumedh Kadam
