Guest Lecture on "Legal Ethics and Advocacy Skills: Understanding Professional Obligations in India"

The session started with an introduction to who is a lawyer-A lawyer is a professional who advises clients on legal matters, represents them in court, and ensures justice is served. To excel in this field, strong analytical and critical thinking skills are paramount. The ability to research, interpret, and apply complex legal principles is crucial. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills are essential for client interaction, negotiation, and persuasive arguments.

Undergraduate students can cultivate these skills by:

- Developing strong research and writing abilities.
- Improving communication and public speaking skills.
- Cultivating critical thinking and problem-solving abilities.


- Engaging in legal awareness activities and mooting competitions.

The Bar Council of India and State Bar Councils regulate the practice of law and ensure adherence to professional ethics. Contempt of court, a serious offense, highlights the importance of upholding the dignity and authority of the judiciary.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where students actively engaged with the speaker, seeking guidance on the practical application of ethical principles and honing their advocacy skills.
