At the entrance to the Supreme Court building, this phrase is inscribed in Devanagari script. The phrase implies that justice must be founded on righteousness in order to deliver triumph to society. It emphasizes the significance of sustaining the ideals of truth, honesty, and integrity in the administration of justice. The word "Yato Dharmastato Jayah" comes from the Mahabharata, an ancient Hindu epic. It is

frequently linked to Yudhishtira's character, who was famed for his dedication to righteousness and truth.

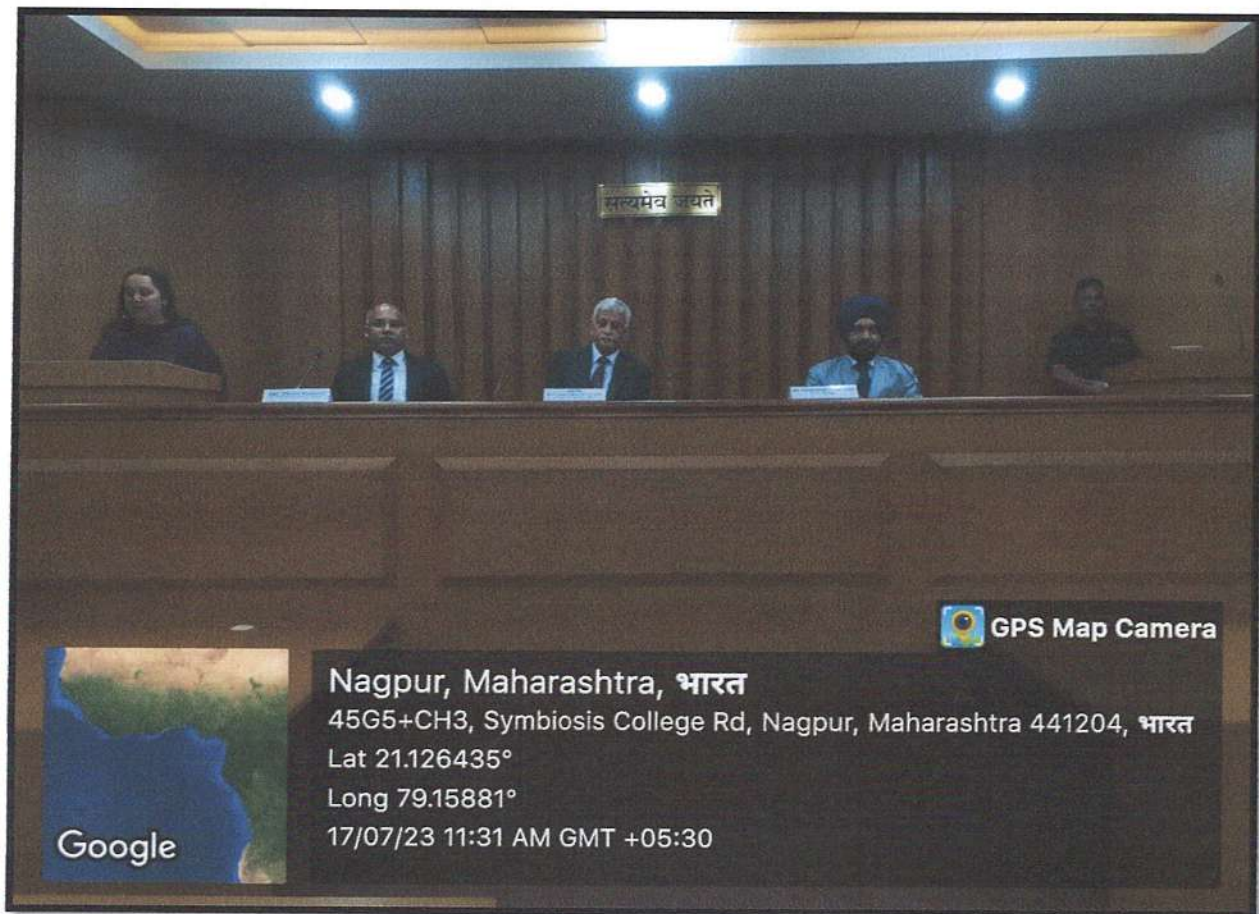

## **CENTER FOR AEROSPACE, MARITIME & DEFENCE LAWS**

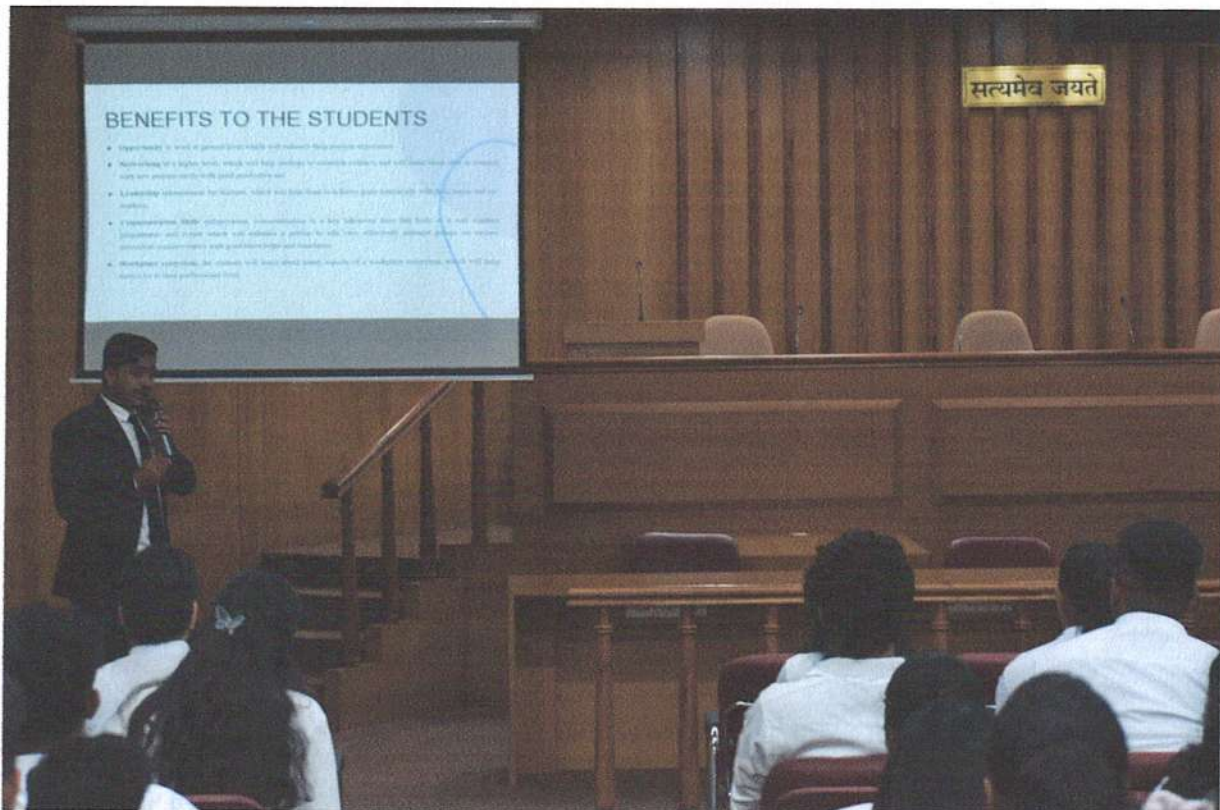

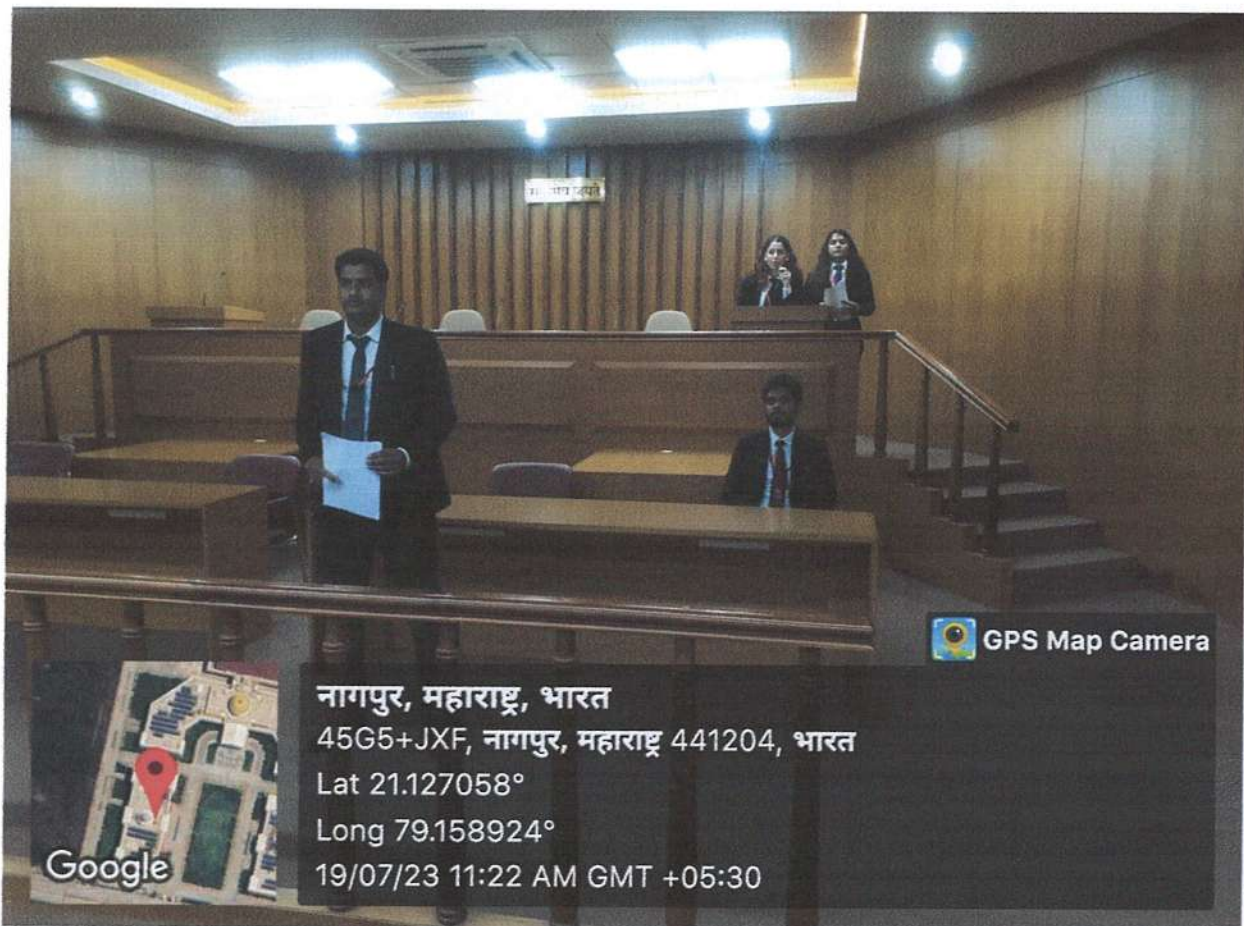

**(DSRW)**

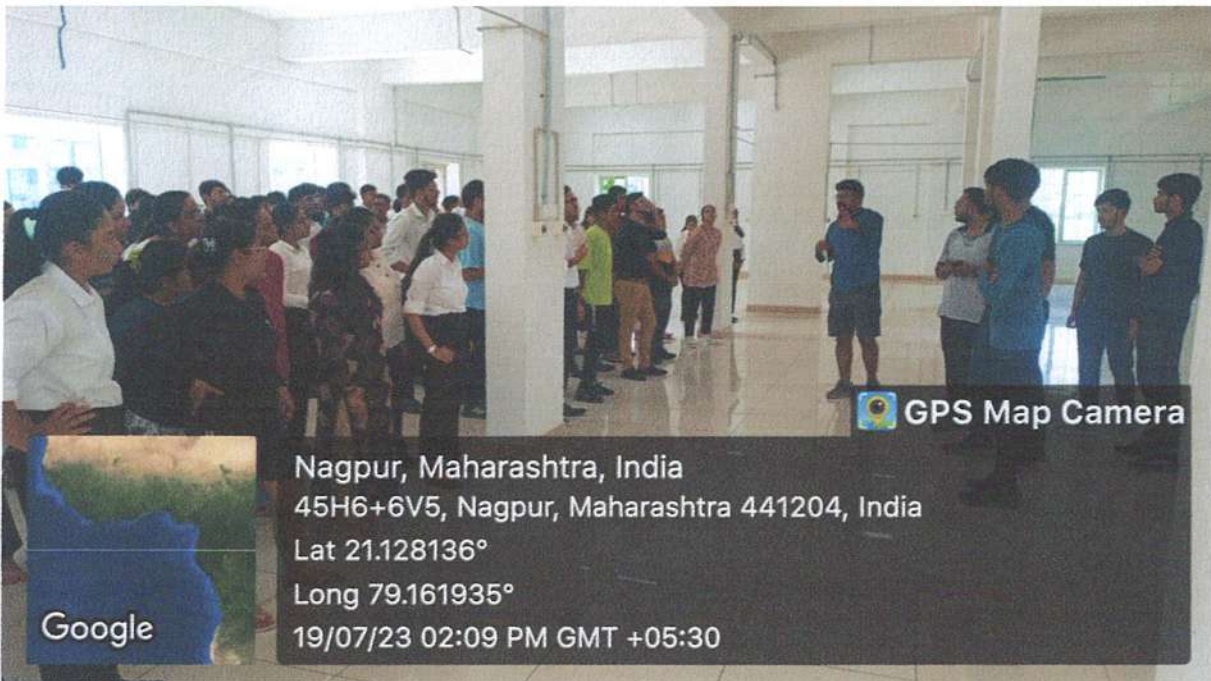

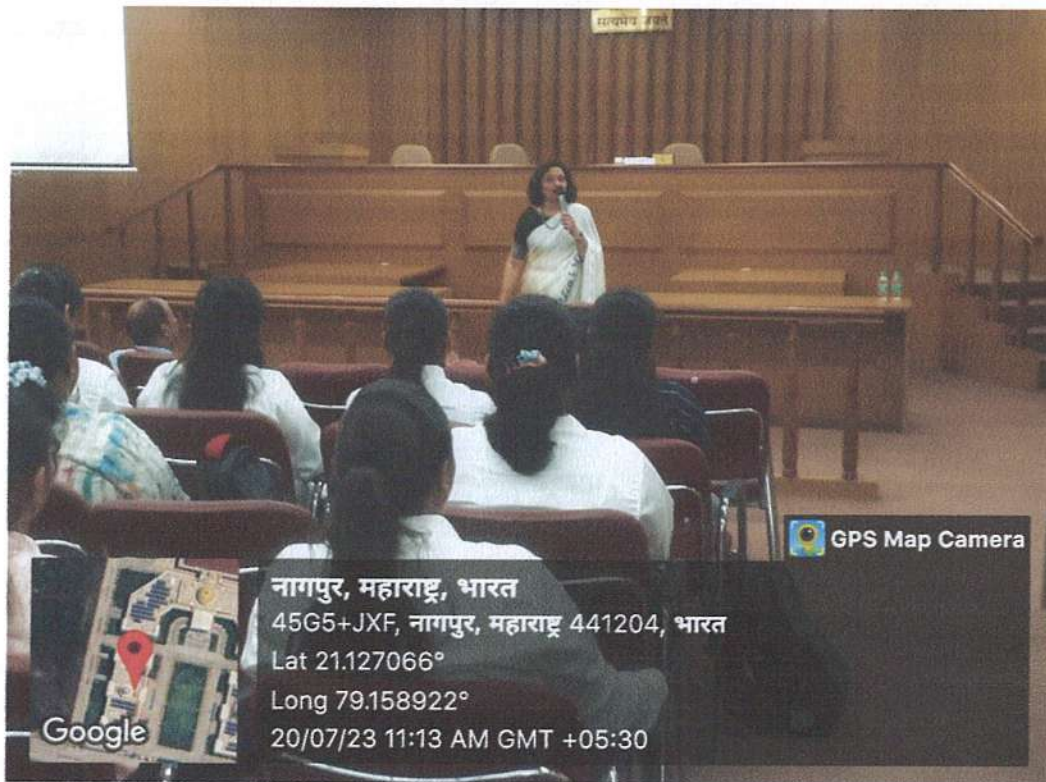

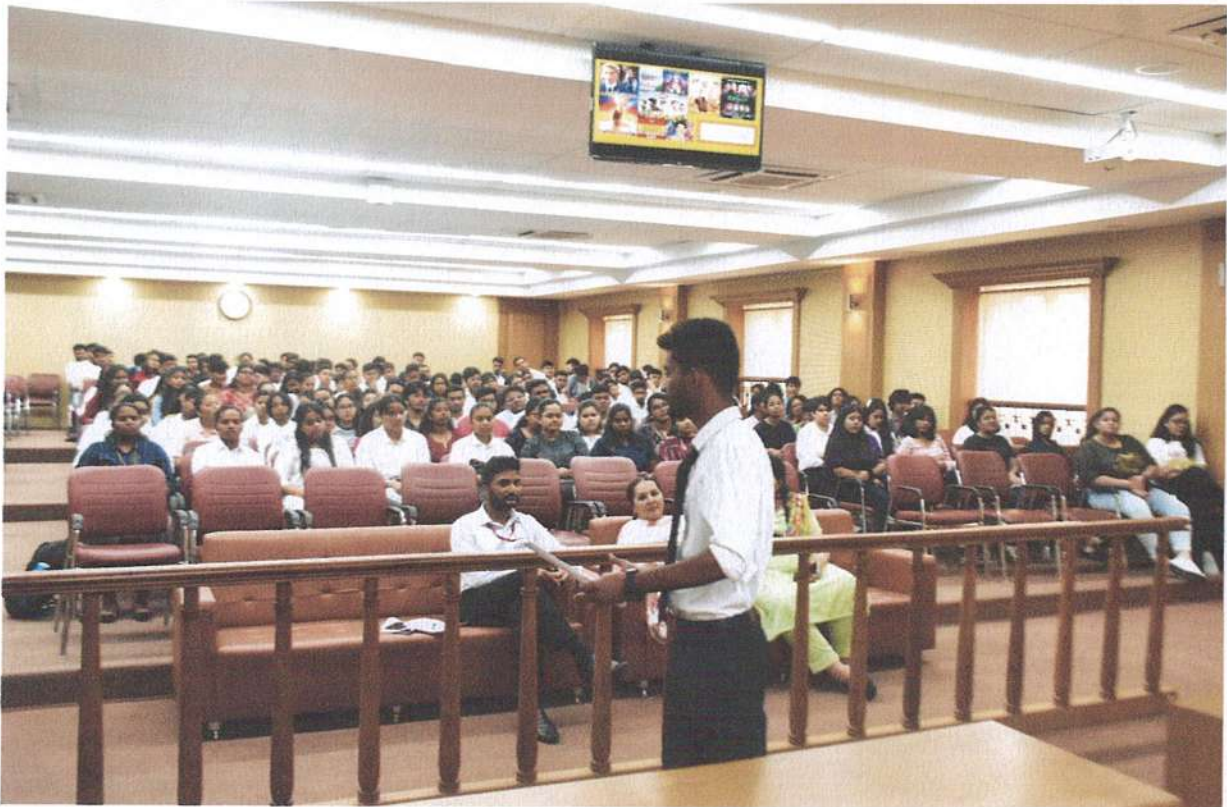

Exploring the connection between media and entertainment laws and suitable restrictions. Understanding the legal operations of cinematography, media houses, and production firms.

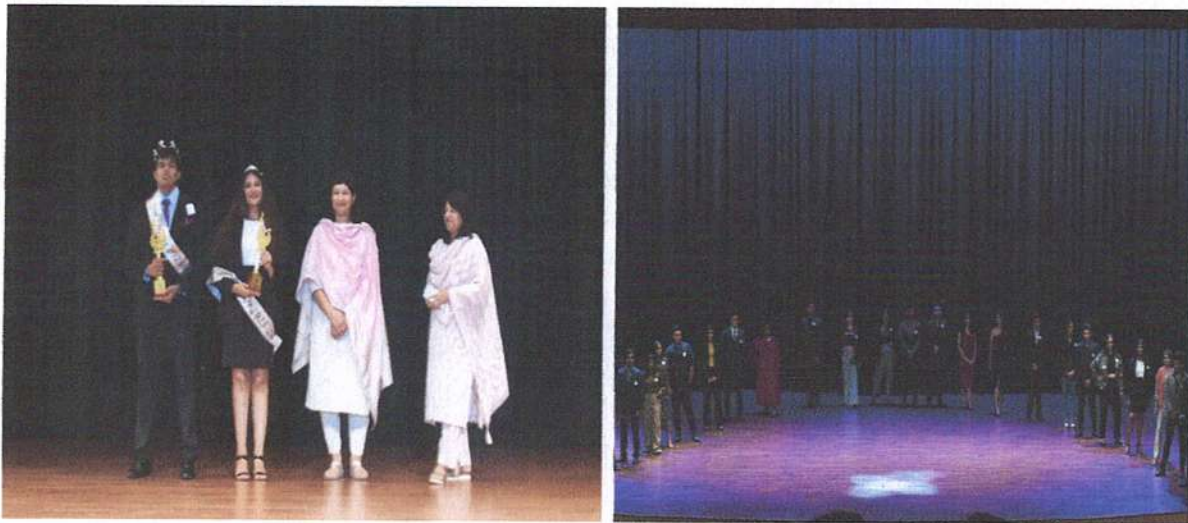

### **DEBATE & LITERARY CELL**

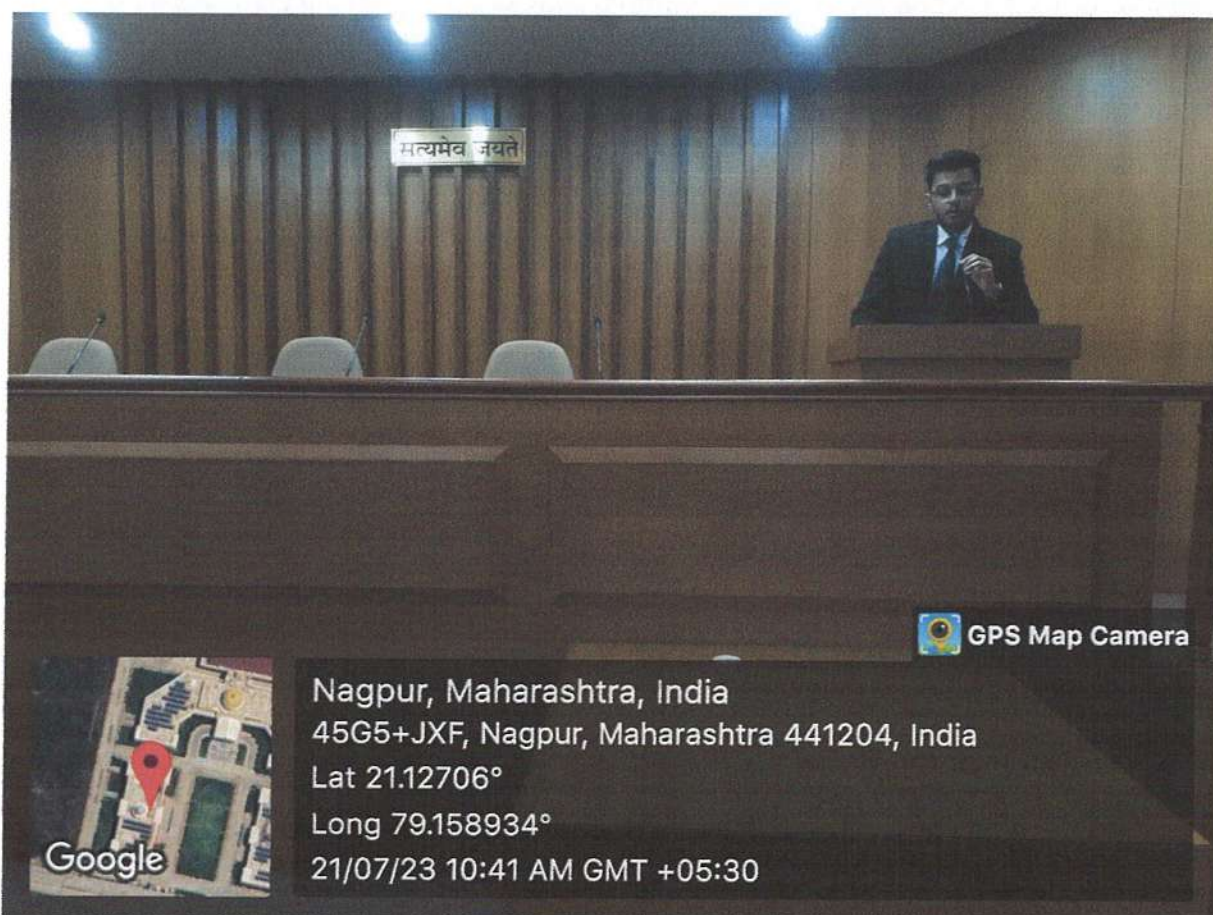

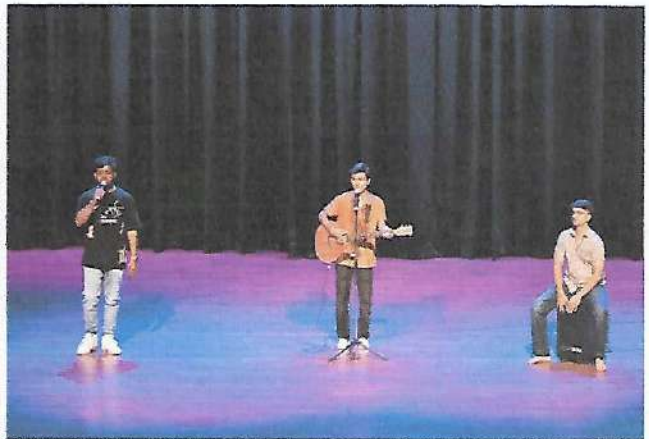
